Z.D. (Dan) Eisenstein Memorial Scholarship 2025 APPLICATION FORM

Each year the Tunnelling Association of Canada (TAC) awards a scholarship in the memory of Professor Dan Eisenstein to a post-graduate student planning to undertake, or currently undertaking, post-graduate studies in the field of tunnelling at a recognized Canadian university. To be considered candidates must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrant with permanent resident status.

Candidates for the award will be evaluated based on the following six (6) criteria:

- 1. Relevance of their research topic to the tunnelling industry;
- 2. Demonstrated record of academic excellence;
- 3. Membership and involvement in TAC;
- 4. Relevant work experience;
- 5. Demonstrated interest in tunnelling; and
- 6. Involvement in extracurricular activities and the community.

The scholarship includes a **cash prize of \$6,000**, a one-year **TAC membership**, as well as full registration and attendance (including economy travel and accommodation) at the **TAC 2025 Vancouver Workshop and Awards Banquet**. Your photo and thesis title will also be posted on the **TAC website www.tunnelcanada.ca!**

To be considered, candidates must submit:

- 1. A completed application form (see next page);
- 2. A curriculum vitae (CV);
- 3. Most recent university transcript (unofficial transcript acceptable); and
- 4. A letter of support from your research advisor.

The deadline for applications is March 14, 2025. Applications are to be submitted by email to the TAC Scholarship Coordinator scholarships@tunnelcanada.ca. Applications received after the submission deadline may not be considered.

TAC reserves the right to reject any application and award the scholarship accordingly. Furthermore, TAC will not communicate with any applicant during the evaluation period.
